In May 2023, Conway Regional marked the successful conclusion of the "Growing Together" capital campaign, surpassing its three-year goal by raising over \$10 million against a target of \$8 million. The funds elevated Conway Regional Medical Center by enhancing the laboratory, bolstering behavioral health services, advancing the Graduate Medical Education program, and finalizing the new Intensive Care Unit.
